Text: Galatians 4:4-5 (ESV)

<sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.

Is. 60:2

1. When religion was vain and empty.
2. When knowledge was an end in itself.
3. When conquest never satisfied and only left life void of meaning.

3. Know God has a sense of timing. (silence is not absence)
