Romans 16:13

"Greet Rufus, a choice man in the Lord, also his mother and mine."

Mark 15:21

"They pressed into service a passer-by coming from the country, Simon of Cyrene (the father of Alexander and Rufus), to bear His cross."

Ephesians 6:2-3

Mark 3:32-35
